Mathematics Curriculum & Algebra Initiatives

- Achieve strategic plan Goal 3C - ensuring all students successfully complete Algebra by grade 8
- Implementation plan: 4th graders of next year will be the first cohort
- Rationale: Algebra opens academic pathways, is standard nationwide, and correlates with higher SAT/PSAT scores
- Parent concerns & feedback
